



PALLAS CAPITAL GOLD CUP 2025

NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

1.1 The Organising Authority is the Australian TP52 Association and events will be conducted by the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia, Corlette Point Sailing Association and Royal Prince Alfred Yacht Club.

2. RULES

2.1 The Pallas Capital Gold Cup 2026 will be governed by:

- the rules, as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 (“RRS”) of World Sailing;
- the IRC 2025 Rules Parts A, B and C;
- the TPR and SFR Rating System Rules, where applicable;
- the TP52 Class Rules, where applicable;
- the Super 40 Class Rules, where applicable;
- the ORC Rules, where applicable;
- the prescriptions and special regulations of Australian Sailing (“AS Special Regulations”).

2.2 The Official Notice Board shall be on the Pallas Capital Gold Cup results site (<https://app.sailsys.com.au/club/147/profile?tab=entrants>). Copies of notices shall be placed on the individual events notice board.

2.3 The Sailing Instructions applicable to the acts that comprise the Pallas Capital Gold Cup shall be the Sailing Instructions applicable to the Pallas Capital Gold Cup.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

3.1 The 2026 Pallas Capital Gold Cup will include the following events:

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 TP52 Class Requirements

A boat shall comply with the TP52 Class Rules and meet the eligibility criteria for IRC Boats in any event comprising the Pallas Capital Gold Cup in which the boat has entered.

4.2 Super 40 Class Requirements

A boat shall comply with the Super 40 Class Rules and meet eligibility criteria for one of IRC Boats or ORC Boats in any event comprising the Pallas Capital Gold Cup in which the boat has entered.

4.3 Divisions

Racing will be conducted in Divisions as follows:

- a) TP52
- b) Super 40s

4.4 Handicap Categories/Class

- a) IRC Handicap Category Boats
A boat may only enter the IRC Handicap Category if the boat has a current, valid Endorsed IRC Certificate.
- b) TPR
A TP52 will automatically be entered in the TPR Division.
- c) SFR
A Super 40 will automatically be entered in the SFR Division.
- d) ORC
A Super 40 may only enter the ORC Handicap Category if the boat has a current, valid ORC Certificate.

5. ENTRIES

5.1 Block entries shall be completed via the online entry [here](#) by 1200 hours 20 February 2026.

Individual Act entries shall be completed via the online entry by 1200 hours the Monday prior to the Act.

5.2 The entry fees are as follows:

Class	Fee
TP52	\$2000 AUD
Super 40	\$1500 AUD
Casual entry (per Act)	\$600 AUD

6. SCORING

6.1 Series Scoring

- a) The Pallas Capital Gold Cup will be scored by the Low Point Scoring system (RRS Appendix A2).
- b) For each event, a boat shall score points equal to her overall placing in the event.

5.2 IRC

- a) Results will be calculated by the application of the IRC Time Corrector (TCC) as a multiplier of elapsed time.
- b) The boat with the lowest corrected time (after application of scoring penalties, if any) will be scored first.

5.3 TPR

- a) Results will be calculated by the application of the TPR Rating as a multiplier of elapsed time.
- b) The boat with the lowest corrected time (after application of scoring penalties, if any) will be scored first.

5.4 SFR

- a) Results will be calculated by the application of the SFR Rating as a multiplier of elapsed time.
- b) The boat with the lowest corrected time (after application of scoring penalties, if any) will be scored first.

5.5 ORC

- a) Results will be calculated by the application of the ORC All Purpose Time on Time as a multiplier of elapsed time.
- b) The boat with the lowest corrected time (after application of scoring penalties, if any) will be scored first.

7. PRIZES

7.1 Prizes will be awarded at the presentation following each regatta, after racing on the Sunday.

7.1 A series prizegiving will be conducted at the conclusion of Act 4 on Sunday 17 May 2026.
